Government intends to bring in educational institutions of global repute to set up campuses in Arunachal Pradesh.



Government intends to set up an Education City of national standards spread over an area of over 20.23 to 40.47 Ha, where institutes of national repute will be encouraged to setup campuses for secondary and higher education.



Subsidies, grants, and tax exemptions are available for investors setting up educational institutions in the State.



State government is aiming to harness SEE (Skill, Education, Employment) Trinity providing 25,000+ employment and self-employment opportunities in next five years.



Gaps in education infrastructure, especially in rural areas, present opportunities for private investment in schools and higher education institutions.



Government programs like Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) and Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) encourage private participation in education development.



Government initiatives under Skill India and SANKALP provide financial and policy support for setting up vocational training centres.



Limited number of higher education institutions creates an opportunity for private players to establish engineering, medical, and management colleges.



Difficult terrain and remote locations make digital education and e-learning platforms highly relevant.
